## What it is & What it isn't



I recently learned of some concern and misconceptions about what 1763 is and what it isn't so i thought i'd share. This is just from my personal experience and point of view. i'm sure 1763 means different things to different people. i'm fairly new so am hoping that those with more experience will weigh in as well.

### **What the 1763 dungeon is:**

The dungeon provides a facility for 3 things:

1. It's a social gathering place where it's okay for folks like me to be themselves. i can dress the way i want to, wild and crazy leather rocker or classic BDSM (with corsets and the like). One of the best parts is the conversations, open & honest, no need to watch what you say for fear of shocking or offending someone.

2. It provides a place and equipment for folks to have a "scene". A scene could be anything from a simple spanking to being set on fire, and everything in between. It can be negotiated at the time, a casual "hey, let's do this", or prearranged "i'll meet you there."

A scene is carefully and respectfully negotiated between the "players". It may be very simple or quite complex, with ropes & suspension. There are discussions about limits (physical and emotional) as well as the desires of both parties.

As a single woman new to the lifestyle 1763 provides safety. There are DMs (dungeon monitors) walking around making sure the scene stays safe and consensual.

3. They offer classes where we can learn new things. We even had a session about the computers, legal ramifications of porn on the internet, work computers vs personal, etc.

## **What it is not:**

Being there does not imply any obligations except to be respectful.

Every activity is optional and consensual. It is a choice to play or watch. There are also places to just sit being quiet or you can join in on one of the amazing conversations.

In my experience all are welcome - all sizes, shapes, colors, ages, preferences, kinks blend together forming an interesting, creative, beautiful tapestry that changes with each visit. Yes, i really do love it. It's become my home away from home.
